

## GRANTS AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS

*in conjunction with the KSU Green Fund:*

If you're a resident of Malta, you have the opportunity to get tax rebates of up to €750 and an extra €1000 when you decide to replace your old vehicle. For those residing in Gozo, the incentive is even higher, reaching up to €2000 for scrapping your vehicle. And that's not all – pedelecs (electric bicycles) are budget-friendly to upkeep, environmentally friendly, and provide a fantastic means of staying physically active. Considering a high-quality ebike costs approximately €2500, you could essentially acquire one with little to no cost!

Individuals investing in new electric vehicles, such as motorcycles, will benefit from grants ranging from €500 for each new pedelec (electrically assisted bicycles) to €2,000–€6,000 for electric motorcycles, tricycles, and quadricycles. Furthermore, substantial grants of €11,000 will be allocated for electric cars and vans, with additional amounts for larger vehicles dedicated to passenger or goods transportation, subject to individual assessment.
